Organisations with strong informal learning capabilities including social learning are 300% more likely to excel at global talent development than organisations without.

Deloitte report 2015



60% of Learning Managers are aware of online communities. However, of this number, only 32% said that their L&D intentionally uses them to support on-the-job learning. Forward-thinking L&D teams can maximise the learning that goes on in communities, by capturing the tacit knowledge that exists within them. This can help to reduce an organisation's reliance on formal training as informal, social learning helps people find what they need, when they need it.

Developments in mobile technology are expected to have the greatest impact on L&D in the next 5 years. Yet currently Only around 25% of organisations are developing and using mobile apps as part of their L&D offering.
